Themes draw from questions such as: How do children in other places live or play? Where does chocolate come from? What do cell phones have to do with globalization? More generally, the themes deal with the topics of global citizenship, intercultural education, and human rights. In our annual program, you will find interesting seminars on the topics of globalization, fair trade, human rights, refugees and asylum, etc.
